THE CHALLENGE

With HIPPA and other security requirements growing more stringent each day, the hospital needed to find a way to ensure the privacy and confidentiality of the information being accessed. At the same time, it was critical not to bog down the hospital's doctors and nurses with a lengthy logon/logoff process that required multiple passwords and various steps.
